Basic Workflow Comparison







Within ArcMap/ArcPro

1. Symbolize and label all basemap and geologic map components



2. Export to .aix (default settings okay)

Within ArcMap/ArcPro Continued

3. Turn off all layers except hillshade



4. Export to .png



* Do this with MapUnitPolys too if using ArcMap*



Within Adobe Illustrator

- Download ArcGIS Maps for Adobe
 log in using ArcGIS online account
- 2. Open .aix file and save as .ai file
- 3. Place the hillshade in the document
 - File > Place
 - Select "Link"
 - Click "Place" and click top left corner of map layout to place image







Within Illustrator Continued

- Place and link any other images or figures that aren't vector files
 - Pasting them in the document creates large file sizes



Kentucky Geological Survey

Saving to PDF in Illustrator

• File > Save As > Save as PDF

- Choose the [Press Quality] Adobe PDF
 - Uncheck "Preserve Illustrator Editing Capabilities"
 - high quality PDF without preserving certain layers and features for editing (reduces file size)
- Ignore the warnings it gives you after you click "Save PDF"
