3..cliff-forming qz ss & qtz (quartzarenite); type sec at Fremont Canyon, s. end of Alcova Reservoir; sec begins at foot of S-facing nose in NE1/4 sec 21, T29N, R83W, Natrona Co, [c. WY] on power plant rd. 2 mi W of intersec w/Kortes Rd; 186' (56.7 m) th at type; ranges to 6' at Hartville Canyon; rocks prev assigned to Deadwood Fm or Guernsey Fm, but lack of glauconite in ss disproves correlation; probably correlates w/Parting Fm of CO, but cannot be traced into area; under: Englewood Fm (Dev-Miss); unconf over: Precamb granite
