4, 12..was Kougarok Gvl; Sainsbury here separates Kougarok Gravels (of Hopkins, 1963) into 2 parts: Kougarok Gvl is retained for Pleist-age material, but lower Tertiary beds are renamed: Noxapaga Fm; consists ss, cgl, thin coal, and fireclays; exposed in trenched pingos; name origin: river; location: W of Noxapaga River, old shaft on Turner Creek, along Dahl Creek
